Parade Rules and Regulations

The Wheels of Progress Parade Committee distributes these rules to each participant in the parade, hoping everyone will follow them. The committee feels that a few sensible rules will insure the safety of participants and spectators so everyone can enjoy the parade.

1. Each parade entrant will appoint a leader to be responsible for the conduct of its parade participants
2. Consumption of alcohol or other intoxicants is not permitted in the staging area or during parade
3. All parade units need to be in staging area by 1:00 p.m.
4. The parade will start at 2:00 p.m. sharp.
5. Keep 50ft intervals, keep the parade moving, and try to avoid a lengthy distance between units.
6. No throwing or handing of candy or other items from moving vehicles. You may have people walk along unit and pass/hand out candy.
7. Sirens: use according to crowd request, all EMS vehicles monitor radio traffic during parade in case parade entrant needs to respond to a call.
8. No "For Sale" signs allowed on any vehicles.
9. No reckless operation of any parade vehicle.
10. All commercial vehicles need to be decorated.

Failure of any participant to comply with the rule listed above will result in being asked to leave the parade line-up by a parade official.
